## QUICK HITS

### KYLE KUZMA

- His 10 games with 30+ points and 41 games with 20+ points are the most in a single season in his career.
- Is one of 10 players in the NBA averaging 22.0+ points, 6.0+ rebounds and 4.0+ assists per game this season.
- Is averaging career-highs in points (22.5 ppg), assists (4.2 apg) and field goal percentage (.461) this season.

### DENI AVDIJA

- Avdija is shooting the ball at a career-best .505 clip this season.
- Is averaging single-season highs in points (13.8) and assists (3.7) per game this season.
- Scored a career-high 43 points and grabbed a season-high 15 rebounds on Jan. 14 at NOP, becoming the first Wizard to record 40+ points and 15+ rebounds in a game since Moses Malone in 1987.
- Has collected SEVEN double-doubles over his last 11 appearances since Feb. 9 at Boston.

### MARVIN BAGLEY III

- Bagley III has SEVEN double-doubles in 18 appearances with the Wizards this season (since Jan. 18).

### JORDAN POOLE

- Poole has topped 30+ points in three of his last eight outings from off the bench, averaging 21.5 points per game over that span.
- Has notched at least one steal in a career-high 39 games this season, also averaging a career-best 1.1 steals per game this season.

### TYUS JONES

- Jones is currently leading the NBA with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 7.4.
- His 12 games with double-figure assists this season are a career-high.
- Has dishd out at least 8+ assists in 17 of his last 25 outings (since Jan. 18), averaging 10.0 assists per game over that span.
- Has dishd out 424 assists compared to just 54 turnovers over the team's last 55 games (since Nov. 13 at Toronto).
- Is averaging a career-best 12.1 points and 7.3 assists per game this season.
- Recorded a career-high 17 assists on Feb. 27 vs. Golden State.

## SERIES NOTES

- The series has been dominated by the home team, as only two times in series history has the road team won in consecutive years (Memphis in 2008-09 and 2009-10 and in 2019-20 to 2020-21). Last season (2022-23), both home teams were victorious.
- The last road team to secure a victory in the series was Memphis on March 2, 2021 (125-111).
- Washington is 10-3 in their last 13 homes games against Memphis dating back to the 2010-11 season.
- Washington has dropped five consecutive road games at Memphis and are 4-18 in 22 games played in Memphis since the team relocated from Vancouver at the beginning of the 2001 season.
- Washington's 115-87 win over Memphis on Nov. 5, 2021 is the largest margin of victory (+28) over the Grizzlies in franchise history, surpassing the previous high of +25 (W, 102-77) set on 1/27/96 when the Grizzlies were still located in Vancouver.

## NOTEABLE CONNECTIONS

**FORMER GRIZZLIES:** Washington guard **Tyus Jones** spent the last four seasons (2019-23) with Memphis, appearing in 288 games (60 starts) for the Grizzlies and averaging 8.3 points, 4.5 assists, and 2.1 rebounds per game ... **Jones** led the NBA in assist-to-turnover ratio in each of his four seasons in Memphis ... Washington Assistant Coach **James Posey** played two seasons for the Grizzlies (2003-05), appearing in 132 games (100 starts) and averaging 11.6 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.6 assists in 29.0 minutes per game ... Wizards TV analyst **Drew Gooden** was drafted fourth overall by Memphis in the 2002 NBA Draft and played in 51 games (29 starts) for the Grizzlies before being traded to Orlando during his rookie season.

**FORMER WIZARDS:** Memphis center **Trey Jemison** signed a 10-day contract with Washington earlier this season (Jan. 20), making his NBA debut with the Wizards and appearing in two total games with the team ... Grizzlies guard **Jordan Goodwin** spent two seasons (2021-23) with the Wizards, appearing in 64 games (seven starts) over that time and posting averages of 6.4 points, 3.2 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game.

**COLLEGE:** Wizards forward **Corey Kispert** and Grizzlies forward **Brandon Clarke** were both starters for the Gonzaga Bulldogs during the 2018-19 season.

## SERIES NOTES

- The season series was split last year, 1-1, with each team winning on the road by five points.
- Houston has won 36 of the 50 games against Washington since the franchises has been named the Wizards and Rockets (1997-present).
- The last time Washington swept the season series was in 1988-89.
- Washington and Houston combined to score 317 points on Oct. 30 in the Wizards' 2019 home opener. The Wizards' 159-158 loss marks the highest-scoring game in regulation of the 21st century.
- On Nov. 26, 2018, Harden (54), Gordon (36), Wall (36) and Beal (32) scored a combined 158 points (59.4% of the points scored in the game) the first time in which all four players in a starting backcourt combined for 150+ points in a game since 1970-71.

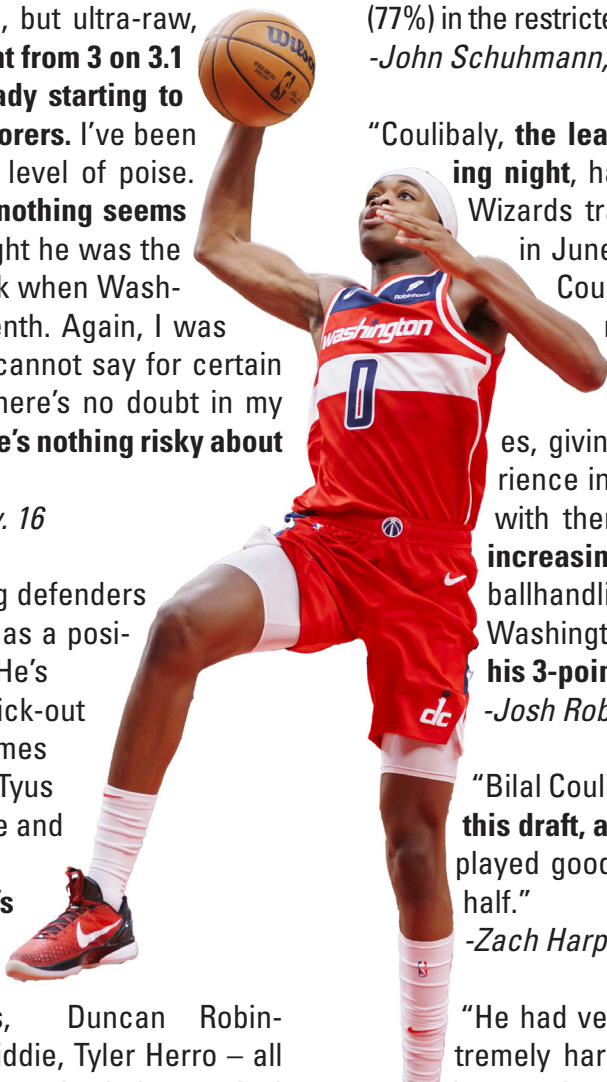

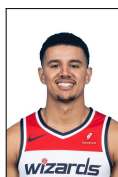
