



Season in Review

Collin Sexton, who scored a career-high 42 points during a 147-135 double-overtime win over Brooklyn on Jan. 20, 2021, joined LeBron James, Kyrie Irving, World B. Free and Mike Mitchell as the only players in franchise history to average 24.0 points in a single season.

CAVALIERS KEY DATES IN THE 2020-21 SEASON

December 23 – Cleveland opened the 2020-21 regular season with a 121-114 home win over Charlotte. The Cavs' 121 points against the Hornets were their 3rd-most ever in a season opener and their most ever at Rocket Mortgage FieldHouse.

Earlier that day, the Cavs exercised the fourth-year (2021-22) contract option on Collin Sexton and the third-year (2021-22) options on Darius Garland, Kevin Porter Jr. and Dylan Windler.

December 26 – The Cavs picked up their first road win of the season, a 128-119 overtime win at Detroit. Darius Garland notched his 1st career 20-10 game and 1st double-double of the season with 21 points (9-14 FG, 3-3 3FG), a career-high 12 assists, five rebounds and two steals in 44 minutes. Kevin Love recorded his 13,000th career point with his seventh point of the night.

December 27 – The Cavs started the season 3-0 after defeating Philadelphia 118-94. It marked their best start since 2016-17 (6-0). Through the first three games, the Cavs' averaged 122.3 points, their highest through the first three games of a season in franchise history.

December 29 – Cedi Osman scored his 2,000th career point with his fourth point against New York. Cleveland tallied 12+ steals for the fourth straight game, just the 2nd time in franchise history the Cavs have posted at least 12 steals in four straight contests, with the first time happening from Nov. 4-15, 1988, which occurred in the first five games of the season.

January 2 – In a 96-91 win over Atlanta, Collin Sexton hit the game-winning three-pointer with 27.9 seconds remaining and scored 13 of his 27 points in the 4th quarter.

January 7 – In Cleveland's 94-90 win at Memphis, Larry Nance Jr. shot perfect from the field (7-7 FG, career-high 4-4 3FG) and finished with 18 points, four assists and three steals in 35 minutes. Nance became the 1st player in Cavs history to go at least 7-7 from the field and 4-4 from three in the same game. He also recorded his 400th career steal with his first swipe.

January 11 – The Cavs signed guard Yogi Ferrell to a 10-day contract.

January 14 – Cleveland acquired center Jarrett Allen and forward Taurean Prince from the Brooklyn Nets as part of a three-team trade.

January 20 – The Cavs defeated the Brooklyn Nets 147-135 in double-overtime. Cleveland's 147 points in the win was their 3rd-most in franchise history and most in any game in almost 30 years. It was also their most points scored at Rocket Mortgage FieldHouse in team history.

Collin Sexton returned to the lineup after a five-game absence due to injury and registered a career-best 42 points (16-29 FG, 5-11 3FG), including a stretch of 20 consecutive points in overtime, five rebounds, five assists, two steals and one block in 38 minutes.

January 22 – The Cavs traded guard Kevin Porter Jr. to Houston in exchange for a future second round draft pick.

January 24 – Collin Sexton became the 3rd-youngest (22 years, 20 days) and 5th-quietest Cavalier (158 games) to reach 3,000 career points with his 12th point at Boston.

January 31 – At Minnesota, Cleveland scored a season-high 72 points in the paint, their most since 2000.

February 1 – In a 100-98 win over Minnesota, Jarrett Allen made his first start as a Cavalier and registered a then season-high 23 points, a season-high tying 18 rebounds and a season-high 5 blocks, becoming the first player in franchise history to reach those marks in a single game.

February 8 – Darius Garland became the 4th-youngest player in franchise history (21 years, 13 days) to score 1,000 career points with his 16th point at Phoenix.

February 19 – Jarrett Allen made his 1,000th career field goal with his seventh make against Denver.

February 21 – Jarrett Allen grabbed his 2,000th career rebound with his seventh board against Oklahoma City. Allen (career-high 26 PTS, 17 REB, 11-11 FG) became the first player in Cavs history and 8th NBA player ever to tally 25+ points and 15+ rebounds while shooting 100% from the field. Allen also became just the 2nd Cavalier to shoot 11-11 of better from the field in a single game (Johnny Warren, 12-12 FG on 12/14/73 vs. BUF).

February 23 – In a 112-111 win over Atlanta, Dylan Windler (career-high 15 PTS) became just the 3rd rookie in Cavs history to go 5-5 or better from three-point range (Kyrie Irving, Jason Kapono).

February 24 – The Cavaliers waived Two-Way center Marques Bolden and signed guard Brodrick Thomas to a Two-Way contract.

March 1 – After a 101-90 victory in Houston, the Cavs reached a season-best 4-game win streak.

March 12 – Cleveland signed guard Quinn Cook to a 10-day contract.

March 19 – Against San Antonio, Lamar Stevens posted his first career double-double with career highs of 15 points and 11 rebounds in just 17 minutes and became the first player in Cavaliers history to put up 15+ points and 10+ rebounds while playing under 18 minutes.

March 22 – The Cavs signed guard Quinn Cook to a second 10-day contract.

March 26 – The Cavs acquired forward/center Isaiah Hartenstein and two second round draft picks from the Denver Nuggets in exchange for center JaVale McGee. Cleveland also reached a buyout agreement with Andre Drummond.

April 5 – Cleveland defeated San Antonio 125-101 on the road. In his 100th career game, Darius Garland scored a career-high 37 points (14-22, 5-10 3FG, 4-4 FT) and added a game-high seven assists in 30 minutes, becoming just the 3rd Cavalier with 35+ points and 5+ threes in a game before age 22 (LeBron James, Kyrie Irving).

April 8 – The Cavs picked up a 129-102 victory in Oklahoma City. It marked just the 2nd time in franchise history the Cavs recorded back-to-back road wins by 20+ points (11/20/2017 at DET 116-88, 11/27/2017 at PHI 113-91). Cleveland also had 35+ assists and 7 turnovers or fewer for the first time since Jan. 23, 2008 vs. Washington (39 AST, 6 TOs).

April 10 – The Cavs signed forward/center Mfondu Kabengele to a 10-day contract.

April 11 – Kevin Love moved past Mark Price (802 3FGM) for 2nd place in three-pointers made with his 3rd triple against New Orleans.

CAVALIERS KEY DATES IN THE 2020-21 SEASON

April 14 – Cleveland won their third straight road game by double-digits after a 103-90 victory in Charlotte. The last time the Cavs had three consecutive double-digit road wins was Dec. 21-29, 2009 (4 straight). The Cavs also handed out 25+ assists for the seventh straight game, their longest since a 9-game streak from Dec. 12-28, 1992.

Kevin Love recorded his 8,000th career rebound and became just 1 of 5 players in NBA history with at least 13,000 points, 8,000 rebounds and 1,000 three-pointers. Love also passed Jim Brewer (3,551 REB) for 9th place in total rebounds with his seventh board.

April 15 - Kevin Love passed Larry Nance (3,561 REB) for 8th place in total rebounds with his sixth board against Golden State.

April 19 – In Detroit, Taurean Prince played in his 300th career game.

April 21 – Against Chicago, Darius Garland made his 200th career three-pointer with his fourth trey, becoming the quickest Cavalier ever to reach that mark (107 Games) and the 3rd-youngest (21 years, 85 days).

The Cavs also signed forward/center Mfondu Kabengele to a second 10-day contract.

April 23 – Darius Garland recorded his 100th career steal with his first swipe at Charlotte. Kevin Love passed Anderson Varejao (2955 DREB) for 6th place in defensive rebounds with his fourth board that night.

April 25 – Matthew Dellavedova made his 400th career three-pointer with his lone triple at Washington.

April 28 – The Cavs signed guard Jeremiah Martin to a Two-Way contract.

April 30 – Collin Sexton made his 300th career three-pointer with his first triple against Washington, becoming the 2nd-quickest Cavalier to reach that mark (198 Games).

May 1 – Cleveland signed forward/center Mfondu Kabengele to a multi-year contract.

May 4 – In an overtime contest against Phoenix, Isaac Okoro put up a career-high 32 points (10-16 FG, 3-4 3FG, 9-9 FT) and a career-high tying six assists in 47 minutes. Collin Sexton also played in his 200th career game and scored his 4,000th career point, becoming the 2nd-youngest Cavalier (22 y, 120 d) to hit that mark behind only LeBron James (20 y, 318 d).

Earlier that day, the Cavs signed center Anderson Varejão, who spent his first 12 seasons with the Wine & Gold, to a 10-day contract.

May 9 – Kevin Love recorded his 500th career steal with his lone swipe against Dallas.

May 10 – Jarrett Allen scored his 3,000th career point with his sixth point against Indiana.

May 16 – The Cavaliers closed out the 2020-21 season averaging 7.76 SPG, their highest since the 2012-13 season (7.89). Cleveland also ranked 6th in the NBA in points in the paint average at 51.1.

June 17 – The NBA announced that Cavaliers guard/forward Isaac Okoro has been selected to the 2020-21 NBA All-Rookie Second Team. Okoro became the 20th rookie in franchise history to earn All-Rookie Team honors.



CLEVELAND CAVALIERS 2020-21 SEASON NOTES

STEALING THE ROCK: The Cavs ranked **12th in SPG this season (7.76)**. The Cavs registered **10+ steals on 19 occasions this season**, their most in a single season since 2014-15 (20 times). This was Cleveland's highest SPG since the 2012-13 season (7.89).

• **2ND TIME EVER:** Cleveland tallied **12+ steals in each of their first 4 games of the 2020-21 season (Dec. 23-29)**. It marked just the **2nd time in franchise history** the Cavs have posted at least 12 steals in four straight contests, with the first time happening from Nov. 4-15, 1988, which occurred in the first five games of the season. (Elias Sports Bureau)

BLOCK PARTY: Cleveland posted **10+ blocks on 4 occasions** this season, including **consecutive games (Feb. 23-24)** for the first time since November 2013 (2 games, 11/9/13-11/11/13).

GETTING IT DONE INSIDE: The Cavs ranked **6th in the NBA in points in the paint average at 51.1**. Cleveland scored **60+ paint points on 16 occasions this season**, which is the team's most in a single campaign in over 20 seasons. (Elias Sports Bureau)

• **72 PAINT POINTS:** Cleveland's 72 points in the paint at Minnesota on Jan. 31 were their most since 2000.

2ND TIME EVER WITH BACK-TO-BACK 20-POINT WINS ON THE ROAD: The Cavs recorded **consecutive wins by 20+ PTS on the road (129-102 at OKC on April 8, 125-101 at SAS on April 5)**, just the **2nd time in franchise history with back-to-back road wins by 20+ PTS (11/20/2017 at DET 116-88, 11/27/2017 at PHI 113-91)**.

• From April 5-14, the Cavs **won 3 straight road games by at least 10 PTS for the first time since Dec. 21-29, 2009 (4 straight)**.

147-POINT NIGHT: The Cavs defeated the Brooklyn Nets 147-135 in double-overtime on Jan. 20. **Cleveland's 147 points in the double-OT win was their 3rd-most in franchise history and most in any game in almost 30 years.**

GONE STREAKING: The Cavs **won at least 3 straight games on 3 occasions** this season (Dec. 23-27, Jan. 15-22, Feb. 23-March 1),

including a **4-game win streak from Feb. 23-March 1**, their longest streak since 2017-18 season. Cleveland opened the 2020-21 season with a **3-0 record, the team's first since 2016-17** when they won their first six contests.

• **GETTING OFFENSIVE:** Over their 3-0 start to open the season, the Cavs' offense averaged **122.3 points (.513 FG%, .434 3FG%)**, their highest through the first three games of a season in Cavaliers history.

NOT SINCE 1992: From April 1-14, the Cavs handed out **25+ AST in 7 straight games**, their longest since a **9-game streak from Dec. 12-28, 1992**.

HIGH SCORING OPENER: Cleveland opened the 2020-21 regular season with a 121-114 win over Charlotte. The Cavs' **121 points** against the Hornets were their **3rd-most ever in a season opener** and **MOST ever in a home opener**.

SEXTON'S SCORING SURGE: COLLIN SEXTON scored **20+ points in 48 of his 60 appearances in 2020-21**, averaging career-highs in PPG (24.3, 18th-best in NBA), FG% (.475), APG (4.4), SPG (1.03) and MPG (35.3). He was **ONE OF ONLY 5 PLAYERS IN THE NBA WITH AT LEAST 24.0 PPG, 4.0 APG, 1.0 SPG, .470 FG%, .370 3FG% AND A .800 FT%** (Kawhi Leonard, Nikola Jokic, Kyrie Irving, Stephen Curry).

• **42 ON THE NETS:** COLLIN SEXTON registered a **career-best 42 points (16-29 FG, 5-11 3FG)**, five rebounds, five assists, two steals and one block in 38 minutes in a double-overtime win over Brooklyn on Jan. 20.

• **2ND CAREER 40-PT GAME:** This was the second time in Sexton's NBA career scoring 40+ points (41 PTS, 3/4/20 vs. BOS). He joins LeBron James and Kyrie Irving as the only players in Cavaliers history to record multiple 40-point games at age 22 or younger.

• **3RD CAVALIER WITH 40-5-5 & .500 FG% SINCE 2010:** Sexton joined LeBron James and Kyrie Irving as the only Cavs players with a 40/5/5 game with .500 FG% since 2010.

• **22 PTS IN BOTH OVERTIMES COMBINED (MOST BY ANY NBA PLAYER SINCE FEB. 2019):** In the last 20 years, the only player to score more points in a game after the 4th quarter than Sexton was D'Angelo Russell on Feb. 13, 2019 (24 PTS in 3 OTs). (Elias Sports Bureau)

• **2ND CAVALIER TO HAVE 20 CONSECUTIVE POINTS IN LAST 20 SEASONS:** Sexton had a stretch of 20 consecutive points (10.7 second mark of 1st OT to 1:29 mark of 2nd OT), including 15 in the second overtime period. He's the 2nd Cavs player to score 20 straight over the last 20 seasons, joining LeBron James. (ESPN Stats & Info)

• **15 POINTS IN THE 2ND OT (MOST BY ANY NBA PLAYER SINCE 2006):** According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Sexton's 15 PTS in the 2nd OT frame are the most by any Cavalier in a single OT in the last 20 years (play-by-play and quarter-by-quarter statistics have not been tracked prior to that). The last NBA player with 15+ points in a single OT period was Washington's Gilbert Arenas in 2006 (16 in OT, 12/17/06 WAS 147 at LAL 141).

OKORO DOING WORK: ISAAC OKORO led all NBA rookies in MPG (32.4) and ranked **6th among rookies in SPG (0.93)**, **10th in APG (1.9)** and **8th in PPG (9.6)**

• **1 OF 5:** ISAAC OKORO was **1 of only 5 rookies** averaging at least 9.0 PPG, 2.0 RPG and 0.9 SPG (LaMelo Ball, Tyrese Haliburton, Jae'Sean Tate, Anthony Edwards).

• **OKORO'S CAREER NIGHT:** Okoro put up a **career-high 32 PTS (10-16 FG, 3-4 3FG, 9-9 FT)** and a **career-high tying 6 AST** in 47 MIN against Phoenix on May 4. He became the **1st Cavs rookie to record 32+ PTS on 16 FGA or less since January 31, 1998 (32 PTS, 12-14 FG by Z. Ilgauskas vs. DET)**.

CLEVELAND CAVALIERS 2020-21 SEASON NOTES

GARLAND'S GAME: Through his 54 appearances, **DARIUS GARLAND** put up career highs in PPG (17.4), RPG (2.4), APG (6.1, 18th in NBA), SPG (1.22), MPG (33.1), FG% (.451) and 3FG% (.395). He also had 6 double-doubles and more 20-PT games this season (20) than last season (6). Garland was 1 of only 4 players in the NBA with 17.0+ PPG, 6.0+ APG, .390+ 3FG% and .840+ FT% (Damian Lillard, Kyrie Irving, Kyle Lowry).

- **DISHING IT OUT:** Garland has handed out 7+ AST on 23 occasions this season, including a career-best 5 consecutive games from Feb. 21-March 1, the longest by any Cavalier since LeBron James' 9-game streak from March 17-April 1, 2018. Garland dished out 10+ AST 6 times this season.
- **BEST IN 100TH GAME:** In his 100th career game on April 5 at San Antonio, **DARIUS GARLAND** scored a career-high 37 PTS (14-22, 5-10 3FG, 4-4 FT) and added a game-high 7 AST, 2 STL and 1 BLK in 30 MIN at San Antonio. He became just the 3rd Cavalier with 35+ PTS and 5+ 3FGM in a game before age 22 (LeBron James, Kyrie Irving).

NEW CAVS MAKING IMPACT: **JARRETT ALLEN** (13.2 PPG, 9.9 RPG, 1.39 BPG, .609 FG%, 51 GP) and **TAUREAN PRINCE** (10.1 PPG, 3.7 RPG, 2.4 APG, 29 GP) each put up solid numbers since joining Cleveland.

- **NEAR THE TOP OF THE FIELD:** Allen ranked 5TH in the NBA in FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE this season at .618 and 9th in BPG (1.43), 13th in RPG (10.0) and T-19th in double-doubles (25).
- **FIRST CAV EVER WITH THESE NUMBERS:** In a win over Minnesota on Feb. 1, Allen registered a season-high 23 PTS on 7-9 (.778) FG, a season-high tying 18 REB and a season-high 5 BLK in 35 MIN in his 1st start as a Cavalier. **Allen is the 1st player in Cavaliers history to post 23 PTS, 18 REB & 5 BLK in a single game.** He is also the 1st NBA player to post that stat line with a FG% of .778 or greater since 2012 (JaVale McGee, 23 PTS, 18 REB, 5 BLK, .846 FG% on 1/14/12 vs. PHI).
- **8TH NBA PLAYER EVER:** Against Oklahoma City on Feb. 21, **JARRETT ALLEN** (career-high 26 PTS, 17 REB, 11-11 FG) became the 1st player in Cavs history and 8th NBA player EVER to tally 25+ PTS and 15+ REB while shooting 100% from the field. Allen also became just the 2nd Cavalier to shoot 11-11 of better from the field in a single game (Johnny Warren, 12-12 FG on 12/14/73 vs. BUF).
- **DOUBLE-DOUBLE STREAK:** **JARRETT ALLEN** notched 6 straight double-doubles from Feb. 14-24, the longest of his NBA career.
- **PRINCE TIES CAREER BEST STREAK:** **TAUREAN PRINCE** scored in double figures in a season-best 7 straight games from April 3-15, which tied his longest double-digit scoring streak in a single season of his NBA career (Feb. 13-March 4, 2018).

5/4/21 - The Cavaliers signed center Anderson Varejão to a 10-day contract; The team was granted a hardship exception by the NBA in order to acquire Varejão.

5/1/21 - The Cavaliers signed forward/center Mfondu Kabengele to a multi-year contract.

4/28/21 - The Cavaliers signed guard Jeremiah Martin to a Two-Way contract.

4/21/21 - The Cavaliers signed forward/center Mfondu Kabengele to a second 10-day contract.

4/14/21 - The Cavaliers signed forward Lamar Stevens to a multi-year contract.

4/10/21 - The Cavaliers signed forward/center Mfondu Kabengele to a 10-day contract.

3/26/21 - The Cavaliers acquired forward/center Isaiah Hartenstein and two second round draft picks from the Denver Nuggets in exchange for center JaVale McGee; Cleveland later reached a buyout agreement with Andre Drummond and requested waivers on the veteran center.

3/22/21 - The Cavaliers signed guard Quinn Cook to a second 10-day contract.

3/12/21 - The Cavaliers signed guard Quinn Cook to a 10-day contract.

2/24/21 - The Cleveland waived Two-Way center Marques Bolden and signed guard Brodrick Thomas to a Two-Way contract.

1/22/21 - The Cavaliers traded guard Kevin Porter Jr. to Houston in exchange for a future second round draft pick.

1/14/21 - The Cavaliers acquired center Jarrett Allen, forward Taurean Prince, and the draft rights to Aleksandar Vezenkov, who was selected by the Nets with the 57th overall pick in the 2017 NBA Draft, from the Brooklyn Nets as part of a three-team trade; Cleveland sent guard Danté Exum and a 2022 unprotected first round draft pick via Milwaukee to Houston, and the lesser of Utah and Cleveland's 2024 second round draft picks to Brooklyn; The Nets received guard James Harden from the Rockets and Houston received forward Caris LeVert, forward Rodions Kurucs, three first round draft picks and the rights to swap four first round draft picks from Brooklyn; The Cavs also waived center Thon Maker and released guard Yogi Ferrell.

1/11/21 - The Cavaliers signed guard Yogi Ferrell to a 10-day contract; The team was granted a hardship exception by the NBA in order to acquire Ferrell.

12/23/20 - The Cavaliers exercised the fourth-year (2021-22) contract option on Collin Sexton and the third-year (2021-22) options on Darius Garland, Kevin Porter Jr. and Dylan Windler.

12/19/20 - The Cavaliers waived Two-Way player Matt Mooney and guard/forwards Levi Randolph and Charles Matthews; The team then converted center Marques Bolden into a Two-Way contract and signed forward Norvel Pelle, who they would waive later that night.

11/30/20 - The Cavaliers added center Thon Maker, center Marques Bolden and guard Charles Matthews to their 2020 training camp roster.

11/28/20 - The Cavaliers signed forward Lamar Stevens from Penn State University to a Two-Way contract.

11/27/20 - The Cavaliers acquired forward Rayjon Tucker (6-5, 210) and a 2027 second round draft pick from the Utah Jazz in exchange for cash considerations.

11/25/20 - The Cavaliers re-signed guard Matthew Dellavedova; also signed guard Damyean (DAME-ee-an) Dotson to a multi-year contract.

11/23/20 - The Cavaliers acquired center JaVale McGee and a 2026 second round draft pick from the Los Angeles Lakers in exchange for forwards Alfonso McKinnie and Jordan Bell;

11/18/20 - The Cavaliers acquired Milwaukee's 2025 second round draft pick in exchange for the draft rights to Ilkan Karaman (originally drafted in 2012 by the Brooklyn Nets); The protections on the first round pick for the first allowable draft (2022) previously conveyed to the Cavaliers from Milwaukee in a trade on Dec. 7, 2018 have been removed, making it an unprotected first round pick.

11/21/20 - The Cavaliers signed their 2020 NBA Draft pick, guard/forward Isaac Okoro.

11/18/20 - The Cavaliers selected guard/forward Isaac Okoro from Auburn University with the fifth overall pick in the 2020 NBA Draft.
