



SEASON IN REVIEW

Cavaliers guard Jordan Clarkson scored 1,364 points off the bench in 2018-19, the most points by a reserve in franchise history.

Cavaliers Key Dates In The 2018-19 Season

October 17 – The Cleveland Cavaliers open the 2018-19 season in Toronto. Cedi Osman recorded his first career double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds in 33 minutes.

October 28 – The Cavaliers released Tyronn Lue as Head Coach and named Larry Drew Interim Head Coach.

October 30 – Cleveland defeats Atlanta 136-114 to notch their first win of the season. The Cavs put up 78 points in the 2nd half (41 in 3rd quarter), their most in a single half since Nov. 23, 2016 versus Portland (81 in 1st half).

Tristan Thompson also passes Anderson Varejao (4,434 REB) for the 5th-most rebounds in franchise history with his 5th board of the night.

November 5 – The Cavaliers signed Larry Drew to a new head coaching contract.

November 13 – A 113-89 Cavaliers victory over Charlotte is highlighted by a Tristan Thompson double-double of 11 points, a career-high tying 21 rebounds and a career-high tying five assists in 28 minutes. Thompson was the first Cavs player to grab 20+ rebounds through the first three quarters of a game since Anderson Varejao (21 through 3rd quarter on 10/30/2012 vs. WSH).

The Cavaliers grab a season-high 60 rebounds, outrebounding the Hornets by a 60-37 (+23) margin, their biggest rebound edge since Feb. 28, 2014 versus Utah (+25, 56-31).

November 19 – Tristan Thompson passes Jim Chones (2,750 DREB) for the 6th-most defensive rebounds in franchise history with his second defensive board at Detroit.

November 23 – The Cavs secure their first road victory of the season at Philadelphia with a 121-112 win. The starting five combined to score a season-high 93 points, highlighted by Rodney Hood (25), Collin Sexton (23), Cedi Osman (20) and Tristan Thompson (18).

November 24 – Against Houston, the Wine & Gold pick up a 117-108 win to record their first set of back-to-back wins of the season. Collin Sexton pours in a career-high 29 points on 14-21 (.667) shooting in 34 minutes of play.

November 28 – At Oklahoma City, Collin Sexton records his 1st career double-double with 21 points and a career-high 10 rebounds in 38 minutes. Sexton became the first Cavs rookie to post at least 20 points and 10 rebounds in a game since March 19, 2012 when Tristan Thompson accomplished that feat (27 PTS, 12 REB vs. Nets).

November 29 – The Cavs acquire guard Alec Burks and two future second round draft picks from the Utah Jazz in exchange for guard Kyle Korver.

December 3 – Alec Burks hammers down a game-winning dunk with 3.2 seconds remaining to give the Cavaliers a 99-97 victory at Brooklyn. Jordan Clarkson recorded his 1st double-double of the season with a team-high 20 points and a career-high 11 rebounds in 28 minutes off the bench. Clarkson became the first Cavs bench player to post at least 20 points and 10 rebounds in less than 30 minutes played since 4/16/14, when Tyler Zeller did it also against Brooklyn (22 PTS, 11 REB, 26 MIN).

December 7 – The Cavaliers acquire guard Matthew Dellavedova and forward/center John Henson from Milwaukee as part of a three-team trade. Cleveland also received Milwaukee's own 2021 first round pick and 2021 second round pick and a 2022 second round pick from Washington. In exchange, Cleveland sent guard George Hill and a 2021 second round pick (Washington's via Utah) to the Bucks and forward Sam Dekker to the Wizards; Milwaukee received forward Jason Smith from Washington.

December 8 – The Cavs pick up a 116-101 win over the Wizards. Tristan Thompson recorded his 15th double-double of the season with a season-best 23 points (11-18 FG), a game-high 19 rebounds, a career-high tying five assists and two blocks in 42 minutes on Saturday. Thompson had 13 points and 11 rebounds in the 2nd quarter alone, his first career double-double in a single period. The last Cavalier to tally a double-double in a single quarter was Anderson Varejao on 1/20/14 vs. Dallas (4th quarter, 10 PTS & 11 REB). With his third board, Thompson passed Hot Rod Williams (4,669 REB) for the 4th-most rebounds in franchise history.

December 10 – Tristan Thompson becomes the 17th player in team history to reach 5,000 career points with his 4th point at Milwaukee.

December 12 – Cleveland closes out the game on an 8-0 run to defeat New York 113-106 and record back-to-back home wins for the first time of the season.

December 18 – The Cavaliers edge the Pacers 92-91 as Larry Nance Jr. scored the game-winning basket with a tip in as time expired. He registered his 3rd double-double of the season with 15 points and game-highs of 16 rebounds, six assists and three steals in 33 minutes.

January 2 – Tristan Thompson made his 2,000th career field goal with his fourth make against Miami.

January 5 – Tristan Thompson passes Brad Daugherty (548 GP) for sole possession of the 9th-most games played in franchise history against New Orleans.

January 9 – In the first quarter at New Orleans, the Cavs shot a perfect 8-8 (1,000) from three-point territory. That was one triple shy of their franchise best start for a single quarter (9-9 3FG in the 1st quarter on 11/15/14 vs. ATL). The bench poured in 75 points, which was their most bench points in a single-game since Feb. 2, 2002 (76 vs. DET).

January 11 – The Wine & Gold shot 24-26 (.923) from the free throw line at Houston, which marked a new franchise single season best 10th game shooting .900 or better from the charity stripe.

January 13 – The Cavs defeat the Lakers 101-95 at Staples Center. Alec Burks posted his 1st double-double of the season (3rd of career) with 17 points and a season-high 13 rebounds in 33 minutes.

January 16 – Jordan Clarkson records his 5,000th career point with his 14th point at Portland.

January 25 – Alec Burks tallied his 4,000th career point with his fourth point against Miami.

January 27 – Cleveland grinds out a 104-101 victory over the Bulls. Alec Burks had the game-winning put back with 17.0 seconds to go to seal the victory.

Cavaliers Key Dates In The 2018-19 Season

January 29 – The Cavs beat Washington at The Q for the second time of the season with a 116-113 win. The Cavs dished out 30 assists on 45 made field goals in the victory and Jordan Clarkson knocked down six three-pointers (6-8 3FG), finishing with a team-high 28 points on 10-15 (.667) shooting from the field and five rebounds in 29 minutes off the bench.

February 4 – The Cavaliers acquire Nik Stauskas, Wade Baldwin IV and two future second round draft picks (Portland's own 2021 and 2023) from the Portland Trail Blazers in exchange for guard Rodney Hood.

February 7 – The Cavs acquire guard Brandon Knight, forward Marquese Chriss, a 2019 first round draft pick and a 2022 second round pick from the Houston Rockets as part of a three-team trade. In exchange, Cleveland sent guards Nik Stauskas and Wade Baldwin IV as well as a 2021 second round draft pick (via Milwaukee) to Houston, and guard Alec Burks to the Sacramento Kings. Houston received guard Iman Shumpert from Sacramento and sent their own 2020 second round pick to the Kings as part of the deal.

February 8 – Jordan Clarkson connects on his 2,000th career field goal with his fourth make at Washington. Kevin Love returns from left foot surgery, recording four points, one rebound and one assist in six minutes of play.

February 11 – Cleveland records their first wire-to-wire win of the season with a 107-104 victory over New York. Larry Nance Jr. posted his career-best 6th consecutive double-double after tallying 15 points on 5-6 (.833) shooting, a game-high 16 rebounds (career-high 10 offensive rebounds), four assists, one steal and one block in 34 minutes.

February 13 – The Cavaliers square off against Brooklyn in a game that lasted three overtimes. It was only the Cavs' third ever game to go at least three overtimes (4OT 154-153 victory versus L.A. Lakers on 1/29/80, 4 OT 131-129 loss at Portland on 10/18/74). The Cavs finished with a season-high 139 points against the Nets, their second highest scoring total ever at Quicken Loans Arena (140 points in OT on 2/7/18 vs. Minnesota). The Cavaliers' bench also poured in a season-high 83 points, the second highest total in franchise history (86 points on 12/17/91 vs. Miami).

Jordan Clarkson led the second unit tallying a career-high 42 points on 16-34 (.471) shooting, including a season-high seven three-point field goals (7-17 3FG), eight rebounds, five assists, one steal and one block in a career-high 48 minutes. Clarkson's 42 points were the most scored by a bench player in franchise history.

February 21 – The Cavs pick up 111-98 victory against Phoenix. The Cavaliers dished out 34 assists on 42 made field goals and scored a season-high 25 fast break points. The Cavs' defense also forced 17 turnovers, which they converted into a season-high tying 28 points.

February 23 – Cleveland records their third win in the last four games with a 112-107 win over Memphis. The Wine & Gold outrebounded the Grizzlies, 52-43. It marked the fourth consecutive game the Cavs have secured 50+ total rebounds, their longest streak since they also went four straight games with at least 50 total rebounds from 2/25/04-3/3/04. Kevin Love recorded his second consecutive double-double with a season-high 32 points on 9-15 (.600) shooting, including connecting on a season-high six three-point field goals (6-9 3FG), a game-high 12 rebounds, one steal and one block in 26 minutes. Love's sole block was his 300th career block.

February 28 – The Cavaliers finish the game on a 21-5 run over the final 3:45 to capture a 125-118 victory at New York. The win also completed a regular season series sweep of the Knicks for the 7th time in franchise history and third time in the last four seasons. The Cavs had four players finish with at least 20 points (Love – 26, Clarkson – 22, Sexton – 22, Osman – 21) for the first time since 2/6/17 at WSH.

March 3 – The Cavs beat the Magic 107-93, improving to 5-3 over their last eight games. The Wine & Gold scored a season-high tying 40 points in the fourth quarter. They also connected on 14 three-pointers, their 10th consecutive game with at least 10 threes. Kevin Love recorded a double-double (7th of the season) with 16 points and a game-high 14 rebounds in 29 minutes. In the process, Love passed Jim Brewer (2,259 DREB) for the 9th-most defensive rebounds in franchise history with his fourth defensive board.

March 6 – Against the Nets, Kevin Love tallies 24 points, a game-high 16 rebounds and goes 4-8 (.500) from deep, his NBA-record 40th career game with at least 20 points, 15 rebounds and 3 three-pointers.

David Nwaba tallied a career-high 22 points on 9-13 (.692) shooting, including 3-5 (.600) from beyond the arc, and one steal in 20 minutes off the bench against the Nets. Larry Nance Jr. recorded his 300th career steal with his second swipe at Brooklyn.

March 8 – The Cavaliers connect on a season-high 19 three-point field goals at Miami (19-43, .442). With his first triple of the night, Collin Sexton moved past Kyrie Irving (73 in 2011-12) for the most threes made in a single-season by a Cavaliers rookie. Sexton also surpassed the 1,000 career-point plateau with his 21st point in the game.

Jordan Clarkson shot 6-10 (.600) from beyond the arc and finished with 21 points in 29 minutes off the bench at Miami. Clarkson knocked down his 500th career three with his first try of the game.

March 11 – Cleveland's 126-101 win over Toronto was their largest margin of victory of the season. The Wine & Gold shot .952 (20-21) from the free throw line versus the Raptors. Collin Sexton posted a game-high 28 points on 10-18 (.556) shooting, including 4-7 (.571) from three-point range, four rebounds, five assists in 36 minutes, while Kevin Love added 16 points and a game-high 18 rebounds in 29 minutes of work. Love also tallied his 3,000th career free throw with his fourth make of the game.

March 12 – At Philadelphia, Cleveland's defense forced 22 turnovers, which they converted into 21 points. The Cavs' defense forced at least 20 turnovers in back-to-back games for the first time since they also did it in two straight games from 2/9/13-2/11/13. The Cavaliers also tied their season high with 25 fast break points against the Sixers.

Collin Sexton posted 26 points (11-20 FG, 4-7 3FG, 35 MIN) at Philadelphia, becoming the first Cavs rookie to score at least 25 points in three consecutive games since LeBron James (3 games, 1/13/04-1/17/04). He is also the first Cavs rookie and only the 4th rookie in NBA history to score 25 points and commit zero turnovers in back-to-back games (since turnovers were tracked in 1977-78), joining Brandon Rush (March 2009), Maurice Taylor (Jan. 1998) and James Edwards (March 1978).

Cavaliers Key Dates In The 2018-19 Season

March 18 – In a 126-119 win over Detroit, the Cavaliers shot a season-high .582 (46-79) from the field along with .500 (11-22) shooting from three-point range. Collin Sexton knocked down five three-point field goals (5-6 3FG), tallying a game-high 27 points and two steals in 33 minutes against Detroit.

Nik Stauskas tallied 15 points in the fourth quarter (4-4 FG, 2-2 3FG, 5-5 FT) to finish with 17 points in 24 minutes off the bench. His 15 points in the fourth period is the most he has ever scored in a single quarter of his NBA career. It was also his first outing scoring in double figures as a member of the Cavaliers. Marquese Chriss recorded his first double-double of the season with 10 points, a season-high 10 rebounds and two blocks in 20 minutes.

March 20 – The Cavs win their 4th straight game at The Q after a 107-102 victory over Milwaukee. Cleveland held the Bucks to 36-91 (.396) shooting from the field and had a 47-17 edge in bench scoring. After pouring in a team-high 25 points (10-18 FG, 4-7 3FG) in the win against Milwaukee, Collin Sexton set a franchise rookie record with 7 straight games with at least 23 points. The previous high mark was held by Austin Carr with 6 straight games with 23+ points in 1972 (2/20/72-3/4/72). Prior to Sexton, the last NBA rookie to score at least 23 points in 7 straight games was Tim Duncan in 1998 (7 games, 4/6/98-4/19/98).

With 23 points, Jordan Clarkson scored at least 20 points for the 21st time this season, setting a new single season career-best (prev. 20 games in 2015-16). Brandon Knight also recorded his 6,000th career point.

March 22 – With his 10th point against the Clippers, Jordan Clarkson passes Campy Russell (1,210 PTS in 81 games off the bench in 1975-76) for the most points by a Cavs reserve in a single season in franchise history. Clarkson also reached 1,000 career assists with his first dish of the night and finished with 20 points, five rebounds, two assists and one steal in 33 minutes.

Collin Sexton scored 20 points, his 8th straight game with at least 20 points, becoming just the 2nd Cavs rookie ever to record eight straight 20+ point games, joining Ron Harper (13 games, 2/25/87-3/20/87). With his first three-pointer, Sexton also became the 26th rookie in NBA history to have 1,000 points and 100 threes in a single season.

March 28 – Kevin Love scores his 12,000th career point with his basket at the 1:41 mark of the fourth quarter at San Antonio. Collin Sexton made 10 of his first 12 field goal attempts and finished the night with a team-high 24 points and three assists in 35 minutes.

March 31 – Collin Sexton finished March (15 games) averaging 22.4 points (.510 FG%, .447 3FG%, .839 FT%). According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Sexton became the 2nd NBA rookie since 1979-80 (when the NBA adopted the three-point line) to average at least 22.0 points while shooting .500 from the field, .400 from three, and .800 from the foul line in a calendar month, joining Larry Bird in February 1980 (26.8 PPG, .525 FG%, .464 3FG%, .857 FT% in 11 games played).

April 1 – With his 6th point at Phoenix, Jordan Clarkson reaches 1,300 points for the season. It was the 19th time a player scored 1,300+ points off the bench in a season since the NBA first noted starters on official box scores in 1970-71.

April 4 – Collin Sexton becomes the 3rd Cavaliers rookie ever to post 1,300 points in a single season with his 9th point at Sacramento. He joined Ron Harper (1,874 PTS in 1986-87) and LeBron James (1,654 PTS in 2003-04) as the only Cavs rookies to ever accomplish that feat.

April 5 – David Nwaba scores his 1,000th career point with his 6th point at Golden State.

April 7 – Against San Antonio, Cleveland swipes a season-high 14 steals, their most in a game since 1/6/17 at Brooklyn (also 14 steals). With his second rebound versus the Spurs, Channing Frye became the 36th player in NBA history to accumulate at least 4,000 rebounds and 1,000 three-pointers.

April 9 – The team renames Quicken Loans Arena to Rocket Mortgage FieldHouse. The announcement was made by Cavaliers Chairman and Quicken Loans Founder and Chairman Dan Gilbert, Quicken Loans CEO Jay Farmer, Cavaliers and Rocket Mortgage FieldHouse CEO Len Komoroski and Cavaliers General Manager Koby Altman. They were joined by Cleveland Mayor Frank Jackson and Cuyahoga County Executive Armond Budish. The new name was revealed in a high-energy video presentation in front of hundreds of guests and media prior to Fan Appreciation Night at the Cavaliers final home game for the 2018-19 season.

With his appearance against Charlotte, Collin Sexton becomes the 8th Cavs rookie to play in all 82 games and the first since Andre Miller in 1999-2000. Sexton scored in double figures for the 23rd consecutive game and a 2018-19 NBA rookie-best 73rd time on the season. Sexton's 119 three-pointers are the most ever by a Cavaliers rookie in a single season as he becomes 1 of 3 rookies on the season to tally at least 1,000 points and 100 three-pointers (Luka Doncic, Trae Young).

Jordan Clarkson scores in double figures 72 times, which ends up being the most among all NBA bench players in 2018-19. His 1,364 points is the highest among reserves in Cavaliers history. The Cavs' bench averaged a franchise-record 42.6 points per game.

Cleveland Cavaliers 2018-19 Season Notes

27 SUITS UP: Cleveland had 27 different players play in a game in 2018-19, which was just shy of the NBA record held by the Memphis Grizzlies (28 players, 2018-19 and 2015-16). The Cavs also had an NBA-high 32 different starting lineups.

SEXTON'S STRONG ROOKIE YEAR: The Cavs' No. 8 pick of the 2018 NBA Draft, Collin Sexton, was the only Cavalier to appear in all 82 games (72 starts) and averaged 16.7 points (3rd-best among rookies), 2.9 rebounds and 3.0 assists (5th among rookies) in 31.8 minutes per game. He also ranked 1st among rookies in free throw percentage (.839) and 2nd in three-point percentage (.402, 18th-best in entire NBA), while scoring in double-digits 73 times, including 27 20+ point outings.

- **3rd NBA ROOKIE EVER:** Sexton became just the 3rd rookie in league history to average at least 16.0 PPG, while shooting .400+ from beyond the arc and .800+ from the foul line (Larry Bird in 1979-80 and Stephen Curry in 2009-10).
- **1,371 POINTS & 16.7 PPG:** Sexton's total points (1,371) this past season ranked 3rd among Cavs rookies in franchise history, trailing only Ron Harper (1,874 PTS) and LeBron James (1,654 PTS). He also had the 10th-highest point total by any NBA rookie since 2009-10. His scoring average (16.7) was the 5th-highest ever recorded by a Cavs rookie (Harper-22.9, Austin Carr-21.2, James-20.9, Kyrie Irving-18.5).
- **DOUBLE-DIGIT LEADER:** Sexton scored in double-digits 73 times this past season (the most among all NBA rookies in 2018-19). His 73 outings with at least 10 points tied LeBron James (73 in 2003-04) for the 2nd-most ever by a Cavs rookie, trailing only Ron Harper (80 in 1986-87).
- **EVERY GAME:** Sexton played in all 82 games for the Cavs in 2018-19, becoming the 8th Cavs rookie to ever accomplish that feat and the first since Andre Miller in 1999-2000. Only two other rookies in 2018-19 played in each of their team's games: Shai Gilgeous-Alexander (LAC) and Mikal Bridges (PHX). Sexton also became the 2nd Cavs rookie to average at least 16.0 points and play in 82 contests (Ron Harper in 86-87) and the first NBA rookie to do so since Karl Anthony-Towns (15-16).
- **THREE-POINT MARK:** Sexton's 119 three-pointers were the most ever by a Cavaliers rookie in a single season (prev. 73 by Kyrie Irving in 2011-12). Sexton was just 1 of 3 rookies this past season to tally at least 1,000 points and 100 three-pointers (Luka Doncic, Trae Young). Sexton's .402 mark from deep was also the 2nd-highest by a Cavs rookie in team history (Daniel Gibson, .419).
- **26th NBA ROOKIE EVER:** With his 100th three-pointer (made on 3/22), Sexton became the 26th rookie in NBA history to have 1,000 points and 100 threes in a single season.
- **23 IN A ROW:** Sexton scored in double figures in 23 consecutive games to end the season (2/23/19-4/9/19). His streak tied Brad Daugherty (23 straight, 1/23/87 to 3/12/87) for the 5th-longest double-digit scoring streak by a Cavs rookie in team history and is the longest by a Cavs rookie since LeBron James' 29 in 2003-04 season. The only longest double figure scoring streaks for a Cavs rookie ahead of Sexton are the following: Ron Harper-69 (11/1/86 to 3/21/87), LeBron James-29 twice (12/9/03 to 2/9/04, 2/18/04 to 4/14/04) and Austin Carr-29 (1/25/72-3/19/72). This past season, only Trae Young (34) and Luke Doncic (26) had longer double-digit scoring streaks by a rookie.
- **20-POINT STREAK:** After scoring at least 20 points in 8 straight games (3/8-3/22), Sexton became just the 2nd Cavs rookie ever to record 8 consecutive 20+ point games, joining Ron Harper (13 games, 2/25/87-3/20/87). His 8 straight 20-point games was also tied for the longest streak by any rookie in the NBA this past season (Trae Young, 8).
- **23-POINT STREAK:** Sexton scored at least 23 points in 7 straight games from March 8-20, becoming the first rookie in Cavaliers history to accomplish that feat. The previous high mark was held by Austin Carr with 6 straight games with 23+ points in 1972 (2/20/72-3/4/72). Prior to Sexton, the last NBA rookie to score at least 23 points in seven straight games was Tim Duncan (7 games, 4/6/98-4/19/98).
- **25 POINTS/0 TURNOVERS IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES:** From March 11-12, Sexton posted consecutive games with at least 25 points and zero turnovers, becoming the first Cavaliers rookie to ever accomplish that feat. He is also only the 4th rookie in NBA history to score 25+ points and commit zero turnovers in back-to-back games, joining Brandon Rush (March 2009), Maurice Taylor (Jan. 1998) and James Edwards (March 1978).
- **A MARCH TO REMEMBER:** Sexton finished March (15 games) averaging 22.4 points (.510 FG%, .447 3FG%, .839 FT%). According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Sexton is the 2nd NBA rookie since 1979-80 (when the NBA adopted the three-point line) to average at least 22.0 points while shooting .500 from the field, .400 from three, and .800 from the foul line in a calendar month, joining Larry Bird in February 1980 (26.8 PPG, .525 FG%, .464 3FG%, .857 FT% in 11 games).

Cleveland Cavaliers 2018-19 Season Notes

IT'S ALL LOVE: Five-time NBA All-Star Kevin Love played in 21 games in 2018-19, posting 12 double-doubles and averaging 17.0 points, 10.9 rebounds and 2.2 assists in 27.2 minutes per game. This was his 7th time of his 11 NBA seasons he averaged a double-double.

- **12K PTS, 7K REB, 1K 3FG:** Love scored his 12,000th career point with his basket at the 1:41 mark of the fourth quarter at San Antonio on 3/28/19, becoming just the 8th player in NBA history to accumulate at least 12,000 points, 7,000 rebounds and 1,000 three-pointers (Dirk Nowitzki, Jason Kidd, Kobe Bryant, Paul Pierce, LeBron James, Rasheed Wallace, Antawn Jamison).

BENCH LIFT: After Cleveland's reserves averaged a franchise-record 41.2 points in 2017-18, the Cavs' reserves broke that mark by putting up 42.6 points per game in 2018-19 (6th-highest in NBA). The bench posted 40+ points 50 times, 50+ points 20 times, 60+ points five times, 70+ points twice and 80+ points once (83 vs. BKN on 2/13/19).

- **A FIRST SINCE NOVEMBER 2010:** From Oct. 19-Nov. 3 and March 18-April 1, the Cavs' reserves tallied at least 40 points in 8 consecutive games. Prior to this past season, the last time they accomplished that feat was a 9-game stretch in November 2010 (11/5/10-11/23/10). (*Elias Sports Bureau*)

- **SECOND TIME EVER:** According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the Cavs' four straight contests with 50+ bench points from Dec. 10-16 matches their franchise record. The only other time Cleveland accomplished that feat was 12/17/1991 to 12/21/1991.

- **BUNCH OF BENCH POINTS:** On Jan. 9 against New Orleans, the Cavaliers' bench poured in 75 points, which was their most bench points in a single-game since Feb. 2, 2002 (76 vs. DET). Cleveland topped that mark with a season-high 83 bench points in a triple-overtime game against Brooklyn on 2/13/19, their 2nd-highest total in franchise history.

INSTANT SCORER: Jordan Clarkson led the Cavs' bench this past season, averaging a career-high 16.8 points (3rd-best among all NBA reserves), a .844 mark from the foul line, 3.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists in 27.3 minutes per game. He scored in double-digits 72 times (MOST among all NBA reserves), including 25 20-point outings and one 30+ performance (42 vs. BKN on 2/13/19).

- **20-10 IN UNDER 30 MIN:** In a win at Brooklyn on 12/3/18, Clarkson registered his 1st double-double of the season (5th of career) with 20 points, a career-high 11 rebounds and four assists in 28 minutes off the bench. He became the first Cavs bench player to post 20+ points and 10+ boards in less than 30 minutes since 4/16/14, when Tyler Zeller did it vs. Brooklyn (22 PTS, 11 REB, 26 MIN).

- **MOST POINTS BY A RESERVE IN TEAM HISTORY:** Against Brooklyn on 2/13/19, Clarkson tallied a career-high 42 points, including a season-high seven three-point field goals (7-17), eight rebounds, five assists, one steal and one block in 48 minutes. Clarkson's 42 points were the most by a bench player in franchise history (prev. 37 points by Phil Hubbard on 12/4/84). It was also his first career 40-point performance, as well as the most points scored by a Cavs player in any game this past season.

- **1,300 BENCH POINTS:** With his 6th point against Phoenix on 4/1/19, Clarkson reached 1,300 points for the 2018-19 season. It was the 19th time a player scored 1,300+ points off the bench in a season since the NBA first noted starters on official box scores in 1970-71.

- **BENCH CONSISTENCY:** Clarkson scored in double figures 72 times, which ended up being the most among all NBA bench players this past season. His 1,364 points (2nd-most for NBA bench players in 2018-19 behind Lou Williams-1,485) was also the highest among reserves in franchise history, surpassing Campy Russell (1,210 PTS in 1975-76). According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Clarkson's career-best 16.84 PPG is the 2nd-highest mark by a Cavs bench player, trailing only John 'Hot Rod' Williams (16.87).

TAKING CARE OF THE ROCK: In 2018-19, the Cavs ranked 9th in the NBA at 13.5 turnovers per game. They have recorded fewer than 10 turnovers on 15 occasions this past season.

- **FIRST TEAM TO DO IT TWICE:** The Cavs recorded only 3 turnovers in a game twice in 2018-19 (vs. LAL on 11/21/18 and at POR 1/16/19), becoming the first team since the NBA began compiling team turnovers on box scores in 1970-71 to have 3 turnovers on two or more occasions in a single season.

Cleveland Cavaliers Playoff Notes

50 BOARDS: The Cavs secured 50+ total rebounds in four consecutive from Feb. 11-23. That was their longest streak since they also went four straight games with at least 50 total rebounds from 2/25/04-3/3/04.

DEEP FIRST-QUARTER: In the first quarter against New Orleans on Jan. 9, the Cavs shot a perfect 8-8 (1.000) from three-point territory. That was one triple shy of their franchise best start for a single quarter (9-9 3FG in the 1st quarter on 11/15/14 vs. ATL).

THANK YOU, CHANNING: Channing Frye played his final NBA game on April 9 against Charlotte, scoring 10 points on 3-6 (.500) shooting, including 2-3 (.667) from long range, in seven minutes off the bench. He was a member of the Cavs' 2016 NBA championship team and dressed up in 180 regular season contests for the Wine & Gold. Over 890 career games, Frye tallied 7,786 points, 4,002 rebounds, 864 assists, 457 steals and 540 blocks. He also made 1,049 three-pointers on .388 shooting from deep, which both rank 2nd in NBA history among players 7-foot or taller.

ON THE LINE: The Cavs had the 7th-highest free throw percentage in the NBA at .792 in 2018-19. That was the 3rd-highest mark in franchise history, trailing only the 1991-92 (.805) and 1992-93 (.802) seasons. The Cavs shot at least .900 from the charity stripe on 15 occasions this past season, their most in a single season. Their previous franchise record was 9 such games in 2017-18.

LARRY'S CAREER YEAR: On the season, Larry Nance Jr. averaged career highs in points (9.4), rebounds (8.2), assists (3.2) and steals (1.49, 15th in NBA) in 26.8 minutes per game. He also had a career-best 18 double-doubles, including a career-long six consecutive double-doubles from Jan. 29-Feb. 11. He handed out a career-high seven assists on six occasions (all coming in 2018-19).

SWIPE STREAK: Nance Jr. recorded at least one steal in a career-high 15 consecutive games from Dec. 8-Jan. 5. During 15-game steal streak, he swiped two or more steals in 11 of the 15 games and totaled 33 steals over the streak.

AT THE BUZZER: Nance Jr. had his first career game-winning buzzer beater with a tip-in at Indiana on Dec. 18, giving the Cavs a 92-91 victory.

HISTORIC END TO YEAR 2018: Nance Jr. closed out 2018 with a historical night at Atlanta on 12/29. He posted 18 points on 7-8 (.875) shooting, while tying his career high in rebounds (15) and assists (7), and tying his season high in steals (4) in 36 minutes of work. Nance Jr. became the first NBA player since 1973-74 (when steals were first tracked) to put up at least 18 points, 15 rebounds, seven assists, four steals and a .875 FG% in a single game.

DOUBLE-T: Tristan Thompson averaged a double-double for the first time of his career with 10.9 points (.529 FG%) and a career-high 10.2 rebounds in 27.9 minutes per game. He also recorded a team-high 19 double-doubles, including two 20-10 games (11/10 at CHI and 12/8 vs. WAS).

• **OFFENSIVE GLASS:** Thompson grabbed a career-high 4.0 offensive rebounds per game. He notched at least 4 offensive rebounds on 22 occasions. Against the Lakers on 11/21/18, he pulled down a season-high 10 offensive rebounds, which was the 5th time in his career he has grabbed at least 10 in a single game.

• **15+ REBOUNDS:** Thompson grabbed at least 15 rebounds in 8 games this past season, a single season career best (previously six 15+ rebounding games in 2012-13 & 2013-14 seasons). He also had two games with 20 or more rebounds this past season (11/13 vs. CHA, 11/24 vs. HOU).

• **CONSECUTIVE DOUBLE-DOUBLES:** Thompson registered a career-high tying 4 straight double-doubles nine times in his career, including 3 times this past season (11/5-11/13, 11/21-11/26 & 11/30-12/5).

• **21 BOARDS IN THREE QUARTERS:** In the win against Charlotte on 11/13, Thompson tied his career highs in rebounds (21) and assists (5), to go with 11 points in three quarters of play (28:13). The last Cavs player to pull down 20+ boards in three quarters was Anderson Varejao (21 through 3Q on 10/30/12 vs. WSH).

THE RISE OF CEDI: Cedi Osman increased his scoring average from last season by 9.1 points (3.9 to 13.0), one of the highest scoring increases in the NBA this past season. In 2018-19, Osman averaged 13.0 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.6 assists in 32.2 minutes per game. He scored in double-digits on 52 occasions, including 20+ points 13 times.

• **A RISING STAR AT 2019 ALL-STAR WEEKEND:** Osman represented the Cavs at 2019 All-Star Weekend in Charlotte as a member of the World Team for the MTN DEW ICE Rising Stars. Osman joined 18 other Cavaliers players who have previously competed in the Rising Stars since its inception in 1994 and was the first Cavalier to appear in the event since Matthew Dellavedova played with the World Team in 2015.
