RECAP: The South Bay Lakers couldn't grab a win on the second night of their back-to-back as they lost to the Austin Spurs, 128-124, on Thursday night. Pierre Jackson led the way for South Bay (14-22) with 28 points, seven rebounds, seven assists and four steals. The Spurs (21-14) were paced by Quindary Weatherspoon who finished with 28 points and seven assists. Jackson was on fire in the first quarter, scoring 14 early points to lead the Lakers to a 37-35 lead after one. South Bay held a 68-58 halftime lead as Devontae Cacok and Jackson combined for 15 points in the second quarter. Austin took control in the third quarter, behind 11 points from Daulton Hommes, to take a 96-87 lead into the final frame. South Bay fought back in the fourth quarter behind a combined 18 points from Wayne Selden Jr. and David Stockton, but the Spurs were able to do enough to hold on for the victory. Jackson's strong scoring performance paced the Lakers, while Stockton (22 points, three rebounds, nine assists and three steals) and Talen Horton-Tucker (20 points, seven rebounds, two steals, one assist and one block) also had solid nights. Cacok tallied his 20th double-double with 19 points, 10 rebounds and one steal. Selden Jr. had a strong night off the bench with 16 points and Reggie Hearn also finished in double figures with 10 points.

RECAP: The South Bay Lakers dropped their penultimate road game of the season as they lost to the Agua Caliente Clippers, 123-120, on Tuesday night. Kostas Antetokounmpo paced South Bay (18-25) with 24 points and a career-high 15 rebounds. The Clippers (22-22) were led by Johnathan Motley's 30-point performance. The home team held a slight 33-29 lead through one as Terance Mann scored 11 points in the opening frame to lead the Clippers. Antetokounmpo took over in the second quarter, scoring 14 points in the period alone, but the Clippers maintained a 67-58 advantage at the half. South Bay narrowed the Clippers lead to six, 96-90, as Devontae Cacok scored 13 points in the third quarter. The Lakers outscored their opponent in the final quarter but couldn't do enough down the stretch to secure the victory. Antetokounmpo's 10th double-double of the season paced the Lakers and Talen Horton-Tucker ended the night with 23 points, seven rebounds and three assists. Cacok and David Stockton scored 17 points apiece, while Pierre Jackson finished with 16 points and seven assists.

LAKERS LATEST

King Me

South Bay picked up their first win over the Stockton Kings on Wednesday, beating the team, 146-137, on Wednesday. Reggie Hearn scored a season-best 25 points, Devontae Cacok tallied his 25th double-double and Talen Horton-Tucker, Pierre Jackson and David Stockton all reached 20 points. South Bay finished with a season-best 40 assists, their first time reaching 40+ assists since Jan. 3, 2015 vs. Reno (47 assists) and scored a season-best 86 points in the first half.

Congrats to Coby

South Bay Lakers Head Coach Coby Karl was named NBA G League Coach of the Month in February, the second honor of his career and first since November 2017. Karl led South Bay to a league-best 7-2 (.778) record in February, their best month of the season and best since November of 2017. For the month, South Bay led the league in points (130.8), points off turnovers (27.3), fast break points (23.2) and points in the paint (62.4). The team also ranked fifth in steals (9.8) and sixth in field goal percentage (.469).

Props to Pappy

Pierre Jackson had his best game of the season against the Agua Caliente Clippers, leading South Bay to a 123-118 win with a season-best 38 points. The point guard finished 10-21 from the field and 6-13 from beyond the arc. In South Bay's last seven games of February, Jackson notched 24.9 points, 6.4 assists and 2.3 steals

February Loving

South Bay has put together some of their best basketball in February, putting together a 7-2 record in the month as the team has won six of their last seven games, including wins over the top two teams in the Western Conference. The team has been led by Pierre Jackson (23.6 points, 6.3 assists, 2.4 steals), Devontae Cacok (19.3 points, 11.0 rebounds) and Talen Horton-Tucker (19.0 points, 6.4 rebounds, 2.6 assists) in their best month of the season

Messed with Texas

The South Bay Lakers picked up their biggest win of the season when they beat the Texas Legends, 140-98, on February 19. The 42-point margin of victory was South Bay's largest win in franchise history, surpassing the previous record of 41 points that was set against the Legends on February 2, 2018.

Can't Be Ta(e)med

Devontae Cacok dominated the start to his rookie season and earned himself a two-way contract with Los Angeles on 12/11/19. He tied his career high in scoring on 2/4 at OKC, finishing with 32 points on 15-16 FG to go along with 11 rebounds in only 19 minutes. Cacok has tallied a double-double in 26 games, has led South Bay in rebounds in 24 games this season and is averaging 19.4 points and 11.9 rebounds in 23.9 minutes. Per 36 minutes, the rookie forward is averaging 29.2 points and 17.9 rebounds.

Stock Rising

David Stockton continues to climb the all-time assists ladder and currently sits at 6th place in the league rankings. In 26 games this season, Stockton has tallied five games with double-digit assists and has notched four double-doubles.

Midseason Marvels

Devontae Cacok and Gary Payton II were named to the Western Conference Midseason All-NBA G League Team on February 10. NBA G League coaches and general managers voted on the top performers from the first half of the season from their respective conferences, based on the performances of players in games through January 28, 2020.

North Bay Norvell

Zach Norvell Jr. became the 27th player in franchise history to receive an NBA Call-Up when he signed a 10-day contract with the Golden State Warriors on Saturday, February 8th. In 29 games with South Bay this season, Norvell averaged 15.2 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists, while in the last 10 games, the rookie guard had upped his production to 20.3 points, 7.2 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 1.3 steals while shooting 45.5 percent from the field and 45.2 percent from three-point range.

Scary Gary

Gary Payton II became the 26th player in team history to receive an NBA Call-Up when he signed with the Washington Wizards on 12/23. Payton II was named NBA G League Player of the Week on 12/16 after averaging 30.7 points, 7.7 rebounds, 10.0 assists, 1.7 steals and 1.3 blocks while shooting 58.7 percent from the field and 90.0 percent from the free throw line. In South Bay's two wins during the week, Gary Payton II averaged 33.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, 10.0 assists, 2.0 steals and 1.5 blocks. He scored a season-best 37 points (14-28 FG) with 10 assists and nine rebounds in South Bay's win over Northern Arizona on 12/13. The fourth-year guard has tallied five consecutive point-assist double-doubles. Payton leads the league in steals per game (3.2) and ranks 10th in the league in rebounds per game (9.5). With LeBron James winning the NBA Western Conference Player of the Week, the duo became the first pair from Los Angeles and South Bay to win the award in the same week since Kobe Bryant and Sean Banks did so on 4/6/08.

Texas Shootout

South Bay put up a season-best 152 points in their win over the Texas Legends on New Year's Eve. Talen Horton-Tucker scored a career-high 35 points as seven Lakers scored in double figures. South Bay shot 63.9 percent from the field (53-83) in the win, the best shooting percentage in a single game by any team this season.

Knocked the Hustle

South Bay ended the longest unbeaten start to a season in NBA G League history as they defeated the Memphis Hustle, 125-118, on 12/7. The second unit combined for 74 points in the win, including a season-high 22 points from Andre Ingram and double-doubles from Devontae Cacok (14 points, 15 rebounds) and Gary Payton II (14 points, 11 assists). South Bay improved to 4-0 when they hold their opponent to under 40.0 percent shooting from the field.

Pump the Brakes!

Despite falling behind by as many as 15 points, South Bay stepped up in the second half of their 129-122 win over Grand Rapids and had their best defensive game of the season. The team tallied a season-best 16 steals, the most steals since 12/29/18, and a season-high eight blocks. They also held Grand Rapids to a season-low 19.2 percent shooting in the third quarter where they outscored the opponent, 38-18.

Smooth Sailing

South Bay swept the first back-to-back of the season as they beat the Clippers on the road (110-93) and the Skyforce at home (121-118). Kostas Antetokounmpo scored a career-high 23 points against the Clippers and Zach Norvell Jr. tallied 23 points against Sioux Falls. Devontae Cacok grabbed a double-double in each contest and Talen Horton-Tucker averaged 19 points across the two games.

Gary Payton: Part II

In his first game since returning to the team, Gary Payton II reminded everyone why he is one of the most exciting players in the league. The fourth-year guard finished South Bay's home opener with 22 points, 11 rebounds, four assists, three steals and two blocks.

Major Leagues

This season, the South Bay Lakers boast five players with NBA experience, including three players that have suited up for both South Bay and the purple-and-gold. Kostas Antetokounmpo has played for Los Angeles, while Reggie Hearn and David Stockton have played in the NBA and each spent time with the Lakers during the 2019 NBA Preseason. Pierre Jackson (Dallas) and Wayne Selden Jr. (New Orleans, Memphis, Chicago) Have also spent time in the league.

Familiar Faces

Across South Bay's roster, plenty of players spent time with the Lakers organization over the summer and at preseason.

- Devontae Cacok averaged 10.3 points and 5.2 rebounds in six preseason games and tallied 12.0 points and 8.5 rebounds across eight summer league contests
- Jordan Caroline sat out preseason, but in five summer league outings, he put up 14.6 points and 4.0 rebounds a night
